- Welcome/Introductions/Overview
 - Meeting brought to order at 6:16 pm
 - Reviewed mission statement, flow of meetings, included process for "motion to approve"
 - PTO vs. fundraising
 - This group used to be PTO but now is a non-profit 501(c)(3) primarily used to raise funds to for field trips, playground equipment, and other needs identified by the school.
 - Question came up from an attendee regarding more formal questions, such as why students are leaving, why are people choosing school choice, etc.
 - Lynn replied that these would be better addressed at a school board meeting or 1:1 meetings, open forum, etc. vs. Falcon Families meetings.
 - Factual piece open record request; other question would be dependent on what is for who to contact.
 - For Falcon Families board meetings there is a teacher sign-up for who attends
 - Feedback: Try to get one teach from each grade level
 - Next steps: FF Board to get with Lynn to discuss next steps for PTO
 - UPDATE 9/18: Board discussed with Lynn and we've decided to keep as is for the 2024-25 school year.
- Principal's Report: Lynn Bub
 - o Gallup survey once a year family version and staff version
 - Working on family engagement conversation with child's teacher, how you engage with your child.
 - Fundraising support rich opportunities students participate in; the school is very appreciative of people volunteering and the ability for Falcon Families to raise money to support.
 - Changes to field trips; trips need to follow the curriculum and allow for children to make the connections
 - Falcon families pays for entry fee and school provides transportation
 - Act 20 new law passed in July; AKA Right to Read Act
 - New assessment prescribed by the state to ensure children can ready proficiently by the end of 3rd grade
 - After the January assessment, any child that needs to be on a reading plan will need a family meeting.
 - Plan to use conference time for this.
 - Feedback consider offering parents an overview/free training for families to get a better understanding
 - Cox Campus literacy series; can create own account
 - Referendum information
