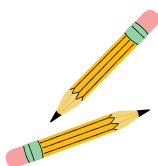

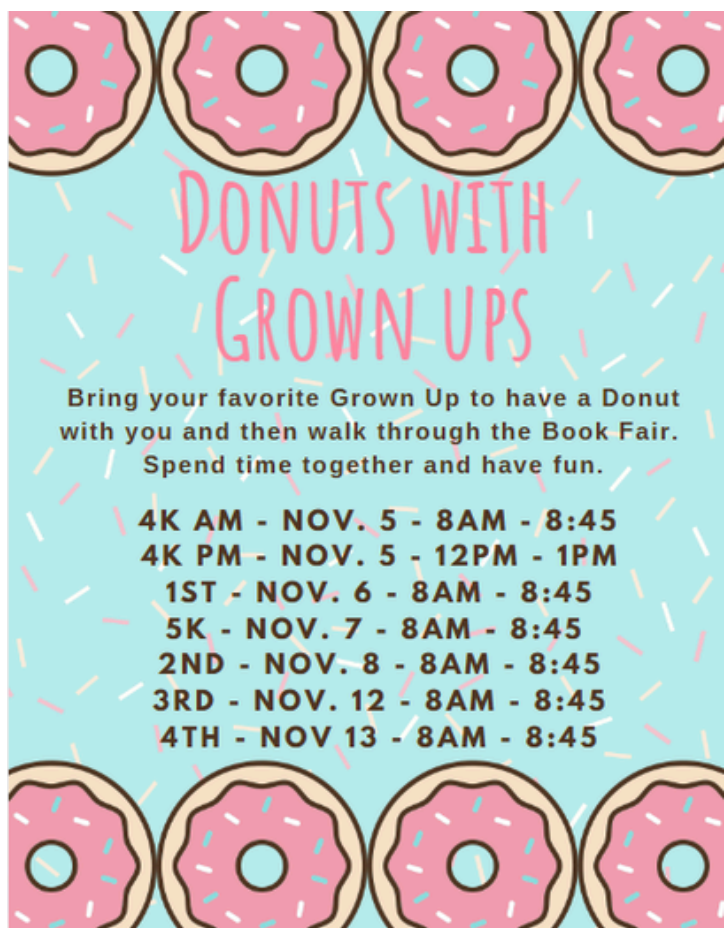

New Requirements This Year

In addition to the required background check, SFES has a new training that all volunteers must complete in order to work with children in the school. Upon completing the background check, you'll receive an email from Sheboygan Falls School Vector Training and be assigned the Title IX training module through the Vector Training system. This online training takes roughly 48 minutes to complete. While it is an extra step, it is necessary to ensure the safety of our children in addition to awareness for all families.
